SUBJECT: Project Lifesaver Training

The Scott County Sheriff's Office will be hosting training on June 22, 2009 from 0900 hours to 1300 hours for Project Lifesaver at Scott County Park in the former Nature Center. Project Lifesaver is a program that provides a tracking system to locate individuals who have the tendency to wander and become lost. Individuals enrolled in the program wear a bracelet on the wrist or ankle that emits a radio signal. A local law enforcement response team utilizes tracking equipment that picks up this signal that is specific and personalized for each individual.

The program is sponsored by Sheriff Dennis Conard, Scott County Sheriff's Office and partnering with Bettendorf Police Department, Blue Grass Police Department, Buffalo Police Department, Davenport Police Department, Walcott Police Department and the Quad Cities Citizens Academy Alumni Association.
